

**215.39****Income Guidelines**

**Introduction** Applicants for the WIC Program must meet income eligibility criteria based on 185 percent of the current Federal Poverty Income Guidelines.

**Current income guidelines** The table below lists the guidelines that are effective for **June 1, 2015 through June 30, 2016**. Applicants with a gross income less than and including the amounts listed are income eligible for WIC services.

**Income determination at integrated clinics** Whenever possible, complete a single income determination. In general, an applicant who is income-eligible for WIC will also be eligible for Maternal Health and Child Health services at no fee.
