Health & Nutrition

Women, Infants & Children

Helps families by providing healthy foods, nutrition education and referrals.

Healthy Pregnancy Program

Provides education, resources and support to pregnant and postpartum women.

Energy Services

Crisis Fund

Pays a portion of rent, utilities, furnace repairs/replacement, water, food or other bills.

Low-Income Home Energy Assistance

Pays a portion of a household utility bill.

Weatherization

Makes energy-efficient repairs to provide comfort and save on utilities.

Outreach Services

Application Center

Community Information Center

Emergency Food Pantry

Provides three day supply of food and household products as available.

Holiday Food

Provides special meals during the holiday season.

Holiday Families

Provides assistance to families with Christmas gifts.

Back to School

Provides school supplies to children.

All services listed are not available at each outreach location.



Children & Families

Child Care Resource & Referral

Provides resources, education and advocacy to support quality child care.

Child Care Collaborative of Iowa

Offers financial management consultation and technology grants to child care businesses.

Family Development & Self-Sufficiency

Provides in-home support to families to address basic needs, improve child well-being and develop career opportunities.

Head Start

Preschool for children ages three and four that provides children with activities to help them grow mentally, socially, emotionally & physically.

Early Head Start

Serves expectant families and families with children birth to three.

Child Development Center

Offers a child development program similar to Head Start for children ages three and four in Hawarden.
